


PISCINA COZZI





With a width of 30 meters and a height of 10, the "Be Water" installation dominates the space and is reflected in the waters of Piscina Cozzi in Milan.

An evocative mural that covered one of the internal facades of the first Italian indoor swimming pool, designed in 1934 by the engineer Luigi Lorenzo Secchi.


